COMPILED EDIPUS DPP PILOT WORKSHOPS REPORT

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Executive summary

In the framework of implementation of the EDIPUS project, the partnership undertook to organize pilot testing phases for the Digital Portfolio Portal (DPP), in order to inform, test and receive suggestions for adjustment of various elements of the Portal design.

Overall, 14 workshops were organised in the six countries of the partnership between February – April 2017, while approximately 252 students were introduced to the use of the DPP and pilot tested the Portal developed.

More specifically, during these workshops the partners' trainers explained what a digital portfolio is, what the benefits of having one are and the best-practices to follow when a student is creating it and trying to promote it to potential employers. Furthermore, the trainers referred to the User Guidebook which has been created in order to facilitate the navigation through the DPP.

Following this theoretical part, participants were introduced to the EDIPUS platform and assisted them in the creation of their portfolios, explaining the different folders in the platform, how they can create content there and which could be the best place to add different content.

Finally, participants provided feedback as regards to the utilization of the User Interface throughout the platform, the usefulness of the terminology and the operation of the functionalities of the DPP. In particular their overview of the DPP was rather positive, being the fact that they stressed the usefulness of the Portal in promoting their skills, experiences and professional profiles in a more effective and "non-traditional" way which showcases their strengths and abilities with "tangible" examples of work.

As a final step of the process participants brought forward suggestions for the optimization of the Portal structure and elements (i.e. include a short walkthrough, investigate the option not only to be Google drive based, include preview as an external viewer, modification of the word interface to upload PDFs, more support for exterior element).

1. EAEC (P1) & ENOROS (P3) Workshops in Cyprus (Nicosia, Limassol)

- **Number of Workshops:** 3
- **Implementation period:** 16 - 17 February, 8 March 2017
- **Participants:** 30
- **Main positive elements indicated:** user friendly, useful, interactive, great opportunity to showcase skills and establish contacts with potential employers, practical
- **Proposed Improvements:** inclusion of an overview of the portfolio, investigate the option not to be Google drive based, include preview as an external viewer, modification of the word interface.

The first pilot workshop on EDIPUS digital portfolios was run by EAEC and Enoros Consulting Ltd on the 16th of February, 2017. The workshop took place at the EAEC office in Nicosia (Cyprus), with 6 university students attended the session that was hosted by the coordinator of the project and president of the EAEC, prof. Gregory Makrides, while Maria Thalia Christou from Enoros Consulting Ltd and Thanasis Tryfonos (EAEC Web Developer), presented the philosophy behind the digital portfolios and the steps that someone has to follow in order to create one.

More specific, Maria Thalia Christou explained what a digital portfolio is, what the benefits of having one are and the best-practices to follow when we are creating it. Following that, Thanasis Tryfonos proceeded to introduce the EDIPUS platform and assist the students in the creation of their portfolios, explaining the different folders in the platform, how they can create content there and which could be the best place to add different content.

The second workshop on EDIPUS digital portfolios took place on the 17th of February, 2017 at the Cyprus University of Technology, in Limassol with 11 university students attending this time. The workshop had the same structure as the previous one. Maria Thalia Christou, explaining what a digital portfolio is, what the benefits of having one are and the best practices to follow when we are creating it. After that, Thanasis Tryfonos proceeded by introducing the EDIPUS platform and assisted the students in developing of their portfolios, explaining the different folders in the platform, how they can create content there and which could be the best place to add different content.

The last EDIPUS digital portfolio workshop took place on the 8th of March, 2017 at the University of Cyprus with 13 university students participants. The workshop was run by Maria Thalia Christou and Loizos Hadjiantonis (EAEC Web Developer).

Students participating in the workshops found the overall operation of the functionalities of the DPP relatively easy. They considered the DPP user friendly, useful, interactive, great opportunity to showcase skills and establish contacts with potential employers, practical. In addition they have provided elements that could be improved in the operation and layout of

the DPP such inclusion of an overview of the portfolio, investigate the option no to be Google drive based, include preview as an external viewer, modify the word interface.

2. ISEP-PORTO (P2), Porto

- **Number of Workshops:** 2 (4 sessions)
- **Implementation period:** 11 & 29 March 2017
- **Participants:** 46
- **Main positive elements indicated:** user friendly, useful, interactive, great opportunity to showcase skills and establish contacts with potential employers, practical, simplicity in operation and design, good tool for students to get more visibility.
- **Proposed Improvements:** modification to be more straight-forward/ clear, inclusion of an overview, include a short walkthrough, investigate the option not only to be Google drive based, include preview as an external viewer, modification of the word interface to upload PDFs, more support for exterior elements such as images and videos.

In Porto, we have realized two EDIPUS workshops. The first one took place on the 11th march 2017, with three sessions running in parallel. The second one took place on the 29th march 2017 with a single session. The workshops were open to all and took place at the School of Engineering of the Polytechnic Institute of Porto (ISEP).

The first workshop was disseminated through the Communication Office of the Polytechnic Institute of Porto, through Praxis channels and through the Portuguese Erasmus+ National Agency (NA). The cooperation of the Portuguese NA in the promotion of the workshop was crucial to attract students and career officers from outside the Polytechnic community. The second workshop was prepared on purpose for the group of international students attending the European Project Semester at ISEP.

We got 60 registrations for the first workshop. For this reason, we have organized three laboratories to run three sessions in parallel. Nuno Escudeiro and Ricardo Almeida, who had attended the EDIPUS training session in Athens, trained two more colleagues – Ana Barata and Alexandra Costa – in the usage of EDIPUS DPP to support the hands-on sessions at the laboratories.

As the second workshop was devoted to the EPS students, 20 students in total, we organized it in a single session.

For the first workshop, from the 60 registered students, 28 attended the sessions coming from 12 different higher education institutions and several undergraduate programmes from IT and design to medicine and nursery. The big number of no-show is probably due to the fact that this first workshop was organized on a Saturday morning. For the second workshop we got 18 students. In total we have trained 46 students.

The feedback from the participants is rather positive (Tables 1 and 2). We have collected this feedback from an online questionnaire that participants filled in at the end of the session and through the open discussion promoted during the last 30 minutes of the workshops.

3. University of Piraeus (P4), Athens

- *Number of Workshops:* 3
- *Implementation period:* 7, 17 and 18 March 2017
- *Participants:* 59

For this stage of the implementation of the project the University of Piraeus organized 3 workshops and 1 follow up meeting with the participants. The details of each workshop are described below.

1st Workshop

The target group of the first workshop was undergraduate students of the University. The workshop took place on the 7th of March and 28 participants attended. During the workshop Dr Kontogoulidou presented the project to the participants and discussed with them the overall objectives and timeline for the project. Dr. Fragkouli delivered the courses for the online platform and the Guidebook based on the material produced by the project. Lastly Ms. Oikonomou worked on the staff level in order to facilitate the implementation of the event.

2nd Workshop

The 2nd Workshop was addressed to the Erasmus Incoming Students of the project and 7 students attended it. During this workshop the same personnel was involved and the same structure was followed.

3rd Workshop

The 3rd Workshop was addressed to the 2nd cycle students of our University and 24 students were present. During this workshop the same personnel was involved and the same structure was followed.

4. UNIMED (P5), Rome

- **Number of Workshops:** 1 (3 day-workshop)
- **Implementation period:** 21,22 & 24 March 2017
- **Participants:** 29
- **Main positive elements indicated:** useful tool for more complete personal and professional presentation of skills and experiences.
- **Proposed Improvements:** possibility to upload the CV in more than one language, possibility to upload PDF files and not only JPG format, limit the option when choosing academic institutions to only the official names of the Universities, Query Code for sending the link to external viewers, inclusion of a direct chat system between students/employers.

The EDIPUS Pilot workshop in Rome took place on March 21, 22 and 24 at the UNIMED premises and welcomed a total of 29 students and young job seekers. Participants came from the following Italian Universities:

- Sapienza University of Rome,
- University of International Studies of Rome – UNINT,
- Bari University,
- University of Perugia,
- Roma Tre University
- Tuscia University.

Participants showed a great interest in knowing a new tool that could be useful for them to have a more complete personal and professional presentation of their skills and experience and not in the classical CV-way. Some questions and suggestions were raised about the functioning of the tool itself.

For international purposes, participants were suggested to use English to fill in the data of the portfolio, unless a particular candidate is interested in a specific country and therefore he/she shall choose to compile the portfolio in a different language. It was also suggested to upload documents in different language if relevant.

4.1. Sample Announcement/Invitation

In order to announce the workshop, UNIMED sent an email directly to the Rectors, Rectors' delegates and International Relations officers of all the Italian Universities associated to the Network. Information about the Workshop was also published on UNIMED website.

4.2. Feedback

- The possibility to upload the CV in more than one language was suggested, but it seems that the platform does not allow renaming the files uploaded: *it is not possible to name the CV: CV English/ CV French/.....*
- Regarding the CV, in the portfolio external preview (i.e. *how the employers will see the portfolios' candidates*), it is not indicated where the CV is stored.
- It could be useful to be able to upload PDF files and not only JPG format. Using the editor, only the JPG format is allowed and, apart from the CV, no other PDF documents are considered.
- Name of Universities. It was noted that names of Universities in the platform vary according to what the user introduce as a name for his/her Alma Mater. A solution should be found in order to allow users to choose only the official name of the University and don't let the platform save all the different variations users could include. This is in order to avoid problems of missing candidates if the employers search by using "Universities" filters.
- The link to the portfolio of the users – outside the platform – could be in the form of a Query Code that could be also putted on Business Cards and CVs. This aspect could help to promote more the platform among the employers and enterprises, which are not in the database at the time candidates apply for a vacancy or give their business cards or leave their CVs.
- Another suggestion which could be useful to make the platform also the main channel of exchange between the users – candidates and employers – could be a "direct chat system" which starts to be active when a profile has been selected in order to have the possibility to scheduling a direct interview also by "chat call".
- The possibility to build a "dynamic" presentation is for sure the more positive aspect of the platform from the participants' point of view.
- One aspect that could increase the interest on the portfolio would be to use a system of internal links among the different pages that could offer a better representation of the platform potential. For example, if in the personal statement students mention languages spoken, could be useful the possibility to have a direct link to the page in which students indicate the languages they know or they work with.

These are the main comments and suggestions made during the workshop. Almost all the participants of the workshop held in Rome replied to the survey at the end of the three-hour workshop.

5. Erasmus Student Network – ESN (P6), Brussels

- **Number of Workshops:** 2
- **Implementation period:** 10 & 25 February 2017
- **Participants:** 45

1st workshop

The first workshop about EDIPUS and the digital portfolios was done by ESN on the 10th of February. The workshop took place in the ESN office in Brussels (Belgium), and around 25 Erasmus students attended the session that was hosted by Gorka Guerrero (ESN Web Developer), after a brief introduction by Rasmus Aberg (ESN Director).

During the workshop, Gorka explained what a digital portfolio is, what the benefits of having one are and the best-practices to follow when we are creating it. After that, he proceeded to introduce the EDIPUS platform and assist the students in the creation of their portfolios, explaining the different folders in the platform, how they can create content there and which could be the best place to add different content.

2st workshop

The second workshop about EDIPUS and the digital portfolios was done by ESN on the 25th of February. The workshop took place in the VUB University in Brussels (Belgium) and around 20 Erasmus students attended the session that was hosted by Gorka Guerrero.

This workshop had the same structure as the previous one, explaining what a digital portfolio is, what the benefits of having one are and the best practices to follow when we are creating it. After that, he proceeded to introduce the EDIPUS platform and assist the students in the creation of their portfolios, explaining the different folders in the platform, how they can create content there and which could be the best place to add different content.

6. University of Vienna (P7), Vienna

- **Number of Workshops:** 5 (only 1 implemented)
- **Implementation period:** 23 -24 March, 18 – 19 April, 12 June 2017
- **Participants:** 13

The first workshop about EDIPUS and the digital portfolios was done at the Center for Doctoral studies at the University of Vienna on 23rd of March 2017. For the workshop were 13 students registered but only two showed up. The session was held by David Zuser (University of Vienna).

The workshop started with an explanation what a digital portfolio is and what are the benefits of it. Before the participants created their own portfolios, some examples of best-practice portfolios were shown to them. After that David Zuser introduced the EDIPUS platform and assisted the students in the creation of their portfolios by explaining the different features of the platform and how to create content to the folders. The participants were very active and interested and managed to create their own portfolio during the session.

There were three other workshops offered to the students on 24th of March and 18th and 19th of April 2017, for these we had zero registrations, although we promoted the workshops through all possible channels.

7. P8. FUERM (P8), Murcia

FUERM organised two workshops about EDIPUS Digital Portfolio.

1st EDIPUS Workshop

It was organized in FUERM premises on 23rd February. In this case, 13 university students attended the workshop that was coordinated and taught by Consuelo García (EDIPUS Project Coordinator in Murcia) and Diane Bulon who is part of FUERM staff and she has been deeply involved in EDIPUS Digital Portfolio Platform.

During the workshop, first of all, a presentation of EDIPUS project was presented. After that, a debate among all participants was created in order to clarify the concept of digital portfolios which is quite unknown in Spain. The trainers presented all the benefits of using digital portfolios, especially for students who are looking for a job. Most part of the training was focused on checking all the different parts of the digital application and the type of content that the students could use to fill in that concrete section of their digital portfolios. Plenty of tips, advice and recommendations were provided to students. Most of the students in the classroom got access to EDIPUS platform and registered themselves during the training session. In order to teach them about how to fill all the different sections of the EDIPUS DPP, FUERM worked with a blanked copy of the platform and also with a practical example done by Diane Bulon who had previously deeply developed her digital portfolio.

2nd EDIPUS Workshop

The second EDIPUS workshop in Murcia took place on 7th March on the premises of Tourism Higher Education Centre in Cartagena (the second main city in the Region of Murcia). FUERM staff disseminated the project among other higher education centres in the Region of Murcia and the responsible of this one in Cartagena asked FUERM to provide their students with this training because they considered it very useful and innovative.

In this case, 17 students attended the training workshop and also 3 teacher from the centre in charge of the professional guidance of students also attended the workshop because they wanted to become trainers in future actions using digital portfolio with other students. This workshop had the same structure than the previous one and the trainers were also the same.
